A. Purpose

To ensure that the City of Anderson Police Department's tactical units maintain a constant state of readiness.

B. Policy


The City of Anderson Police Department's tactical unit(s) will at all times strive to maintain their skill and readiness at a level commensurate with national and/or state standards.

Tactical unit members must have ample opportunity to practice their special skills and develop their abilities to function effectively as a unit. Special training for tactical units is necessary and mandatory because many skills are perishable and should be exercised in order to build and maintain proficiency. Operational simulations should be included in training programs. All tactical training will be documented and the records shall be maintained.

C. Procedures

1. Requirements for specific tactical units shall be stated in the form of general orders and included in the General Orders Manual as addendums to this policy (For example, the addendum for the SWAT Unit should be 1114-A, the Bomb Squad should be 1114-B, etc.). Revisions will be notated by following the general order number with a decimal, followed by the number of the revision (For example, 1114.1, 1114-A.1, 1114-B.1, etc.). Also refer to General Orders series 1500 and 1700.
2. If and when established, each tactical unit shall have separate general orders stating the required training for the affected unit.
 - a. The general orders will be numbered as follows:
 - (1) Special Weapons and Tactics Unit 1114-A
 - (2) Bomb Squad 1114-B
 - (3) Canine (K-9) Unit 1114-C
 - (4) Community Patrol 1114-D
 - (5) Additional G/Os as necessary 1114-E thru Z
