I. Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to state the source of material(s) which govern the pursuit of motor vehicles.

II. Policy:

All officers of the City of Anderson Police Department must receive instruction in the policy and procedures of the city's pursuit policy at least yearly. The Captain of Support Services will maintain records for verifying that each sworn officer has successfully completed this yearly training. The lead Captain in the chain-of-command for the training division shall verify that all lesson plans include all state mandated materials and are in accordance with S.C.L.E.A. standards.

III. Procedure:

- A. At least one time per year, every sworn officer must complete training on the agency's pursuit policy.
- B. The training shall include all state mandated materials and be updated to include changes in criminal and tort law.
- C. The training shall be updated to include changes in officer liability.
- D. Lesson plan for pursuit policy.
 - 1. The yearly training will include at a minimum:
 - a. Evaluating the circumstances,
 - b. Initiating officer's responsibilities,
 - c. Designating secondary unit's responsibilities,
 - d. Assigning dispatcher's responsibilities,
 - e. Describing supervisor's responsibilities,
 - f. Using forcible stopping/roadblocks,
 - g. Specifying when to terminate a pursuit,
 - h. Engaging in inter- and intrajurisdictional pursuits involving personnel from the City of Anderson Police Department and/or other jurisdictions, and
 - i. Detailing a procedure for a critique of the pursuit as soon as possible.
- E. The materials in the lesson plan on Pursuit of Motor Vehicles constitute the city's policy on pursuit and will be adhered to by all City of Anderson Police Department personnel.
