A. Policy

1. Every prisoner being transported to city court shall be secured with leg restraints or similar device(s) unless there is a mitigating circumstance that would justify transporting the prisoner without leg restraints.
 - (a) Mitigating circumstances may include but are not limited to the following:
 - (1) The prisoner is a double amputee.
 - (2) The prisoner is missing only one lower extremity and seems unable to outrun officers.
 - (3) The prisoner is wheelchair bound.
 - (4) The prisoner has a condition that could be aggravated by leg restraints.

2. Whenever a prisoner who is being transported to court is considered a security hazard, the judge will be notified. The judge may direct the use of restraining devices in court or request additional officers to be present.
