A. Policy

1. In those cases when an officer must transport a juvenile or a prisoner of the opposite sex, the officer must exercise proper discretion during the search and restraint of the prisoner.
2. During local transports, the transporting officer shall call in the starting and ending mileage to the communications center.
 - a. The on-duty communications center operator shall reply to each of these transmissions with the time of day.
 - b. All transmissions are recorded in the communications center.
3. In the case of extended transports or an extradition, two officers shall conduct the transport.
 - a. At least one of the officers should be of the same sex as the prisoner.
4. Regarding unscreened vehicles, only under very unusual and articulable circumstances should a single officer transport a single prisoner of a different sex or a juvenile of any sex in the front seat. (Please refer to General Order 1903)
