A. Policy

- 1. In those cases when an officer must transport a juvenile or a prisoner of the opposite sex, the officer must exercise proper discretion during the search and restraint of the prisoner.
- 2. During local transports, the transporting officer shall call in the starting and ending mileage to the communications center.
 - a. The on-duty communications center operator shall reply to each of these transmissions with the time of day.
 - b. All transmissions are recorded in the communications center.
- 3. In the case of extended transports or an extradition, two officers shall conduct the transport.
 - a. At least one of the officers should be of the same sex as the prisoner.
- 4. Regarding unscreened vehicles, only under very unusual and articulable circumstances should a single officer transport a single prisoner of a different sex or a juvenile of any sex in the front seat. (Please refer to General Order 1903)
