A. Policy

Unusual circumstances surrounding special situations, such as transporting prisoners to funerals, visiting the critically ill and the reading of wills provide extra-ordinary opportunities for a prisoner to escape, to inflict injury on himself or others and to contact unauthorized personnel. Prior to transporting prisoners in special situations, officers must obtain written approval from the Chief of Police or the Chief's designee. (An email may suffice as written approval.) The written approval must state:

- 1. the reason for the transport,
- 2. the destination,
- 3. the personal contacts to be allowed for the prisoner (if any),
- 4. and the use of restraints.
- 5. Other relevant information will also be included in the approval.

If the transport is approved, the level of security and the measures taken to provide prisoner security shall be commensurate with the seriousness of the offense for which the inmate is incarcerated.
