A. Policy

1. All marked patrol vehicles used primarily for transportation of prisoners as well as any other vehicles used primarily for the transportation of prisoners will be equipped with protective cages, screens, partitions, or barriers which separate the driver (transporting officer) from the prisoner.
 - a. The safety barrier prevents the prisoner from having access to the driver's compartment of the vehicle. Installation of such a barrier should be done in such a manner that promotes the safety of occupants in the front and rear compartments.
2. Barrier(s) between the front and rear compartments should not be imposed to the point that it precludes conversation.
