**A. Policy**

In the event of an escape the on-duty shift supervisor will be summoned immediately along with the Jail Administrator. A BOLO (*Be On the Look Out for*) will be put out to all surrounding agencies and counties. This includes the SC Highway Patrol for the immediate area. The last known clothing description, physical description, name, and original charge will be placed in the BOLO information. If deemed appropriate by the shift supervisor, the patrol units will establish a perimeter. If deemed appropriate by the shift supervisor, the K-9 services of the City of Anderson Police Department or an agency with which the City of Anderson Police Department has a mutual aid agreement will be requested. The shift supervisor shall assume command of the situation until relieved as described by procedure. The Jail Administrator shall notify the Chief of Police concerning the incident. The person(s) discovering or allowing the escape will file a detailed statement. An internal review will be conducted as described within the City of Anderson Police Department's Internal Affairs procedures. A final written report will be forwarded to the Chief of Police through the Internal Affairs Coordinator. The alert will end (1) upon apprehension of the escapee and/or (2) when the Chief of Police deems an end of the alert is reasonable.
