A. Policy

A threatening incident is defined as any medical emergency, vandalism or damage to the property within the detention area, or physical harm caused to any person/officer within the detention area.

Any action, behavior or activity that is defined as a threatening incident toward the City of Anderson Detention Center or any person therein must be immediately reported to the on-duty supervisor who will document the incident through the writing of a departmental incident report.

The supervisor will write the report and gather any written statements or physical evidence in the same fashion as if the supervisor were handling any other call for service. This report will be forwarded to the jail administrator who will follow-up on the incident, if required.
