A. Purpose:

To establish the City of Anderson Police Department's current perspective on Auxiliary Units.

- 1. A statement that:
 - a. Auxiliaries are not commissioned with sworn officer status; and
 - b. Describes the duties of auxiliaries. (a and b meet SCLEA 6.1.8)
- 2. A statement or general order stating that auxiliaries are to receive training in those duties they are anticipated to carry out. (SCLEA 6.1.9)
- 3. A statement or general order stating that if auxiliaries wear uniforms, the uniforms clearly distinguish them from sworn officers. (SCLEA 6.1.10)
