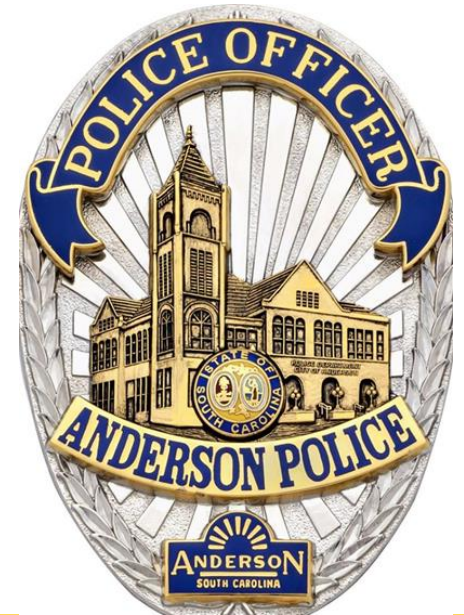

# WHAT IS THE APD CITIZEN ACADEMY?

The Anderson Police Department Citizens Academy is a 10-week program designed to provide community residents with first-hand information about how their police department operates and why.

Participation in the CPA requires a commitment of one night a week for 10 weeks, with classes meeting each Tuesday night from 6 to 8pm.

All classes are held in the City, unless otherwise specified, and are taught by the Command Staff or state-certified law enforcement instructors.

Applications for the **Fall 2019 Academy**, which begins on **October 1** and runs through **December 3**, are available at the Anderson PD and our website [www.cityofandersonpd.com](http://www.cityofandersonpd.com).

Applications are due by **September 18**.

Participants must be 18 years of age or older with no criminal convictions other than minor traffic offenses.

We encourage men and women, young and old to apply. First priority will be given to those applicants who reside or employed inside the corporate limits of the City of Anderson.
