

How do I apply?

Applications for the **Spring 2020 Academy**, which begins on **FEBRUARY 4** and runs through **APRIL 7**, are available at the Anderson PD and our website www.cityofandersonpd.com.

Applications are due by January 24th.

Participants must be 18 years of age or older with no criminal convictions other than minor traffic offenses.
