A. Purpose

To provide guidelines for proper training of new recruits prior to the new recruits being allowed to carry firearm(s).


B. Policy

All non-certified newly sworn personnel will successfully complete basic recruit training in accordance with the South Carolina Code of Laws and the rules and regulations of the South Carolina Criminal Justice Training Council.

C. Procedures

1. This basic recruit training will be completed prior to any routine assignment in any capacity in which the officer is allowed to carry a weapon or is in a position to enforce the law or make an arrest. (SCLEA 11.1.8)
 - a. Exception: as part of a formal field-training program.
2. Recruits who are awaiting their basic training at the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy may be utilized in other areas of the police department that do not require a member to carry a firearm or make arrests.
