
A. Purpose

To establish professional standards of conduct for meetings with Internal Affairs Coordinator(s).

B. Policy

It is the policy of the City of Anderson Police Department to treat all citizens with the highest level of professionalism. This policy extends to conduct and behavior between members of the agency. When a member of the agency who is the subject of an internal investigation is reporting to the Internal Affairs Office, the Office of the Chief or to the office of any other personnel assigned to conduct and/or assist in an Internal Affairs investigation, all weapons including but not limited to firearms, tasers, knives, and impact weapons must be locked away in the interviewee's vehicle and/or in the lock boxes located inside the City of Anderson Police Department. Any deviation from this general order must be approved in advance by the interviewer.
