A. Policy

1. The City of Anderson Detention Center holding facilities will meet or exceed the following minimum conditions for detainees:
 - a. The lighting, and fresh air flow for the detention area will be specified to meet all jail requirements as prescribed in the minimum jail standards. The SC Department of Corrections (SCDC) will set these standards. Compliance with these standards will be known through the annual inspection completed by SCDC.
 - b. All cells and holding areas will be equipped with access to adequate drinking water and toilet operations.
 - c. Each cell and holding area will be equipped so as to provide access to a washbasin for all detainees held in excess of 6 hours.
 - d. A bed and bedding will be provided to detainees held in excess of 6 hours. Necessary bedding will be issued to detainees, as needed, by the on-duty detention officer.

2. **Any person who is held in custody and is deemed suicidal during the initial screening, or from past history, will not be issued bedding or any other item that could be used as an instrument to take their life.**
