**A. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this general order is to define how the disposition of court cases is recorded.


**B. POLICY**

The policy for this general order is defined in the procedures.

**C. PROCEDURES FOR RECORDING THE DISPOSITION OF CASES**

1. All City of Anderson Police Department cases presented to the judicial system for prosecution will have the final disposition recorded in the arrested person(s) I.D. Jacket.
2. The dispositions from Anderson Municipal Court are forwarded, by the Court Office Staff, to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.
  - a. Note: The City of Anderson Municipal Court and all its personnel are under the jurisdiction and supervision of the Judicial branch of government (i.e., the court system). The City of Anderson Police Department is part of the Executive branch of government. Therefore, neither the City of Anderson Police Department's Records Unit nor any other City of Anderson Police Department Unit has any dominion or control over the Judicial Department.
